



## **POSITION AVAILABLE: MEDICAL ADVOCATE**

### **Qualifications and Requirements:**

- Bachelor's degree in Human Services or related field OR related experience.
- Experience with crisis intervention is preferred.
- Completion of 40-hour ICASA crisis intervention training by start of employment.

**Position Details:** Two Medical Advocates will be hired, and each Advocate will work two, week-long shifts per month. During a shift, the Medical Advocate must be available on weeknights and on weekends to respond to all medical calls to the Emergency Departments at Carle and Presence. Each Advocate will be paid a monthly stipend whether or not medical advocacy is required/provided during the course of the month. The advocate must be able to respond to calls to the hospital within 45 minutes.

**Salary:** A stipend of \$500 minus withholding and the employee's share of FICA will be paid monthly. During weekdays, medical advocacy will be provided by RACES staff. If medical advocacy is needed during the weekday and a Medical Advocate is available, the Medical Advocate will be paid hourly to provide those services in addition to the \$500 monthly stipend.

**Benefits:** There are no benefits with this position.
